# JASPER DE BEIJER

Dutch artist, Jasper de Beijer, is currently having an exhibit at MCA DENVER. He has a wicked process for creating a single piece of art and presents an interesting perspective on photography and the photographic process. He takes photographs, creates sculptures/models out of those photographs; then photographs these three-dimensional creations with the objective of the final photograph being the piece of art to be exhibited. It's an unusual exhibit because MCA DENVER is including a selection of miniature props de Beijer made and then photographed as a key element of his process. The artist also works on a computer to alter the photos before they're printed. Interestingly enough, this is the first time that the models and the photos have been brought together in a single display.
